



Updates from the weekend:

D and C section response teams have had a very busy weekend with officers drafted in to assist Plymouth with the aftermath of the WW2 bomb at the start of the weekend. All response sections have had short notice changes to shift times with all 3 sections working 12 hour shifts this weekend. Saturday evening shift started with 2 separate reports of drink drivers, both of whom have been charged to court. Our Roads Policing officers then spotted a suspicious vehicle which was subject to some recent intelligence. When they stopped the vehicle, the passenger immediately ran off. All response units and a Dog unit attended and the driver was located a short while later about to get into another vehicle, having been hiding in a bush. He was suspected to have been in possession of a knife and a small quantity of drugs whilst in the original vehicle and is currently bailed pending further enquires.

Sunday saw a male wanted on warrant located and housed for court in the morning along with a number of domestic and other incidents.

In between all this we have conducted mobile patrols on both nights of the College Lane / Helman Tor View & Kestell Parc areas, and also St Marys Road, St Georges Crescent, Treningle and Kinsman areas on Sunday night in response to recent reports of criminal damage.
