Highways Work & Maintenance in Blisland

One of the things that the Parish Council has been looking at has been to address some of the highways issues in the Parish; you may have noticed that a number of the road markings at the Mansion House and Tregenna Road junctions with the Green have been renewed and a small culvert has been created to channel the water run off (which was an ice hazard last Winter) clear of the highway by the Triangle opposite Denham House; although there might be a little bit more work to be done here. The Council are also initiating some steps to improve the maintenance and appearance of the Telephone Box (which is still owned by BT and remains functional to make calls).



Two other issues are in the process of being addressed; the water run off by St Pratt's Cross (work is scheduled for this November) and the broken highway and run off down Waterloo Hill; both of these will require temporary road closures (which takes around three months for Cornwall Council to set up).
