





Neighbourhood Policing Week - Bodmin Moor ATV patrols

As part of Neighbourhood Policing Week, the Bodmin Moor Rural Crime Initiative All-Terrain Vehicle was out and about patrolling some of the key locations on Bodmin Moor where there are continuing issues with illegal off roading, fly tipping and livestock worrying.

Illegal off roading causes damage to the landscape, heritage sites and can harm livestock. It is an offence to use vehicles off road without lawful authority. Fly tipping is the illegal dumping of waste onto any land and is a criminal offence. Livestock worrying is a crime and livestock that are chased or attacked by dogs are frequently killed or injured.
