The minutes of the last meeting were agreed as a true record of the meeting.

Matters Arising

Window Frames – update Rick has had a look at the wooden window frames which need attention – rubbing down and re varnishing. A specification sheet will be produced. It was agreed that 3 quotes will be sort.

Oil Tank – update Rick and Len have done a temporary repair using an aluminum sheet. It was agreed that this was a sufficient solution.

A leak in the gutter had been reported. The installer has been contacted and he is due to check it out later this week.

He went through the meter figures which had gone from 31 cubic meters and similar readings to 89 it was agreed to address this issue as soon as possible. Len will monitor the meter on Saturday 11th January.
