Treasurer's Report

Ron had circulated his report prior to the meeting. He went through the figures highlighting the fact that the Village Hall had received the Government £10,000 grant which had been a great help as with no bookings there were still overheads to pay.

He was concerned that the electricity is £100 a month seemed high and it would appear to be mainly due to the de humidifiers running constantly. After discussion it was agreed keep the one behind the stage running and put a chemical one in the Manor Suite and monitor the situation.

re extending the furlough if restrictions are not lifted. Katy was very grateful for the furlough arrangement, which is costing us £240 a month, and she is keen to resume duties once restrictions allow.

Following the resignation of Ann Bogle over the car parking decision, it was agreed that a thank you card go to Ann for all her input on the committee this will be accompanied by a bouquet which Len will organise.

Len will liaise with people who have booked the hall after 2nd December and will speak with Sandra about the bookings and he will liaise with Katy once restrictions are lifted.
